- Aluminum, Steel, Bi-metal and Tin Cans
- Plastic Bottles and Containers
 (McCullough/Waste Management customers Stamped #1 & #2)
 (Allied Waste/Leck customers Stamped #1 thru #7
- Corrugated Cardboard (must be flattened, no larger than approximately 2 ft by 2 ft)

COMMERCIAL BUSINESS AND OFFICE RECYCLABLES

- Office/Computer/Writing Paper
- Newspapers/Magazines/Catalogs
- Junk Mail
 (Place all the above in a clear plastic bag)
