AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER MAKEFIELD, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 190 – “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC,” SECTION 3 – “PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS” TO ESTABLISH PARKING REGULATIONS WITH RESPECT TO WILDFLOWER CIRCLE.

WHEREAS, the Township of Lower Makefield is a township of the second class (hereinafter sometimes referred to as the “Township”), organized and operating in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Second Class Township Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the Board of Supervisors of Lower Makefield Township (hereinafter referred to as the “Board of Supervisors”) has the authority to enact, amend, and repeal the provisions of the Lower Makefield Township Code of Ordinances (hereinafter referred to as the “Code”); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that it is necessary to amend the Code to establish a non-parking zone restricting parking along the westside of Wildflower Circle and both sides of the cul-de-sac. Parking will be allowed on the east side of Wildflower Circle only.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Township of Lower Makefield, Bucks County Pennsylvania, and it is hereby **ORDAINED** and **ENACTED** by the authority of same as follows:

1. The Code of the Township of Lower Makefield is hereby revised by amending Chapter 190 – “Vehicles and Traffic,” Section 3 – “Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations,” to add a new entry for Wildflower Circle, at the appropriate alphabetical position in the table in that Section, as follows:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Wildflower Circle	West	From Willow Pond Drive along the west side of the street and through both sides of the cul-de-sac to the East Side of Wildflower Circle

2. All other ordinances, portions of ordinances, or any section of the Code inconsistent with this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.
3. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any section, clause, sentence part or provision thereof shall be held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional section, clause, sentence or part of a provision had not been included herein.
4. This Ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after enactment.
