REV. WILLIAM BROGDEN DEAD

**Well Known as a Camp Meeting
Exhorter and Local Preacher.**

Rev William Brogden, a respected colored resident of Morrisville, died at his home in that borough on Sunday, after a lingering illness. He was a local preacher in the Morrisville A. M. E. Church, and was well known not only among the people of his own race, but also among the whites, as a powerful and eloquent exhorter, and was especially effective as a camp worker.

He was a slave in Virginia 75 years ago, and served in the union army during the war of the rebellion. After receiving his discharge from the service he located in Morrisville, where he and his wife have since resided. He was a member of Thomas Hamden Post, No. 56, G. A. R., of this city.

The funeral will be held tomorrow at 11 o'clock, with interment at the Stone Graveyard, Yardley.
