

*Melancholy Accident.*—We are informed that on Tuesday night last, as Cormick Nicholson, of Upper Makefield township in this County, was returning from Philadelphia with his team, between Oxford and Somerville, fell out of his wagon, the wheels of which passed over his head and breast. His black man, who was driving another wagon not far behind, discovered his body laying in the road, and as soon he found it was his master, applied for assistance at a neighboring house.—Medical aid was immediately sent for, but he was too much injured to receive any relief, and he died the next morning. He was about 60 years of age, and sustained the reputation of a very industrious citizen.
