**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LOWER MAKEFIELD, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING THE LOWER MAKEFIELD TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES CHAPTER 190 SECTION 6 TO CREATE A STOP INTERSECTION AT STACY DRIVE AND STACKHOUSE DRIVE AND AT LAUREL LANE AND STACKHOUSE DRIVE**

**WHEREAS**, Section 1527 (53 P.S. § 66527) of the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code provides that the corporate powers of the Board of Supervisors of Lower Makefield Township (the “Board of Supervisors”) include the ability to secure the safety of persons or property within the Township;

**WHEREAS**, Section 6124 (75 Pa. C.S. § 6124) of the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code provides that local authorities on intersections of highways under their jurisdiction may erect and maintain stop signs, yield signs or other official traffic-control devices to designate through highways or to designate intersections at which vehicular traffic on one or more of the roadways should yield or stop and yield before entering the intersection;

**WHEREAS**, Section 1601 of the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code provides that the Board of Supervisors may adopt Ordinances in which general or specific powers of the Township may be exercised, and, by the enactment of subsequent Ordinances, the Board of Supervisors may amend, repeal, or revise existing Ordinances (53 P.S. § 66601);

**WHEREAS**, the proposed amendments have been advertised, considered, and reviewed in accordance with Pennsylvania law;

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the foregoing, be it **ENACTED** and **ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of Lower Makefield Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, that Chapter 190 of the Lower Makefield Township Code of Ordinances is **AMENDED** as follows:

**I. AMEND Section 190-6** as follows:

**A.** Add “Stacy Drive” and “Stackhouse Drive” under the columns provided therein in the manner set forth below:

<b>Stop Sign On</b>	<b>At Intersection With</b>
Stacy Drive	Stackhouse Drive

**B.** Add “Laurel Lane” and “Stackhouse Drive” under the columns provided therein in the manner set forth below:

<b>Stop Sign On</b>	<b>At Intersection With</b>
Laurel Lane	Stackhouse Drive

**II. Partial Repealer**

All other provisions of the Ordinances of Lower Makefield Township, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect. All other Ordinances or provisions of the Ordinance inconsistent herewith or in conflict with any of the terms hereof are, to the extent of said inconsistencies or conflicts, hereby specifically repealed.

**III. Severability**

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any section, clause, sentence, part or provision thereof shall be held illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair any of the remaining sections, clauses, sentences, parts or provisions of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Township Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional section, clause, sentence or part of a provision had not been included herein.

**IV. Effective Date**

All provisions of this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days after the approval and adoption.
