Essential Functions:

- Remain alert and use all senses when monitoring campers and the facility.
- Assist in camp groups to ensure compliance with camp rules, spot hazards, and take precautions to prevent accidents.
- Enforce facility and camp rules at camp location, as well as on off-site trips.
- Work as a team with camp staff.
- Assist with set up and break down of camp activities.
- Help maintain a clean and safe environment. May occasionally remove trash, sweep, or mop debris, and disinfect surfaces without maintenance staff.
- Participate in and attend staff meetings.
- Perform additional duties as assigned.
